

TRAVEL ADVICE FOR THE GENERAL PUBLIC

The FIFA Club World Cup Qatar 2020[™], presented by Alibaba Cloud, will be held from 4-11 February, with matches taking place at Ahmad Bin Ali Stadium and Education City Stadium.



Doha Metro and local roads are expected to be busier than usual immediately before and after each match. In addition, temporary road restrictions will be in place near each stadium.

Members of the public are advised to allow extra time if travelling during busy periods:

- Avoid travelling at the busiest times as shown in the table below for Doha Metro
- Roads around each stadium are expected to be busier than usual two hours before and two hours after each match
